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## **Broker's Report**

Est. SELF Prem.

### Administrator's Report

The claims administrator for the O.S.S., Erik Knak from Knak & Company, presented the O.S.S. Loss History Review 1998-99 through 2004-05, (attachment B). He mentioned as of May 23, 2005, the total incurred for the 04/05 fiscal year was right at \$500,000. The O.S.S. currently has 68 open claims.

### **Loss Control** Report

Online Training Staff In-Service

O.S.S. risk manager, Dr. Henry Brock reported on utilizing the training modules available through the O.S.S. web site - www.ossweb.org - Risk Management - Online Safety Training Modules. The first module New Employee Safety Orientation (All Employees) was the best place to begin. The other modules would also be beneficial as time permits. He is planning on emailing to all O.S.S. district liaisons a safety bulletin addressing this issue.

Online Training

Sexual Harassment The two hour sexual harassment online training for all supervisors should be up and running by 8/01/05. This training will be available in  $4 - \frac{1}{2}$  hour modules.
