Treasurer's Report	The O.S.S. accountant, Carol Williamson, presented the financial statement for quarter ending March 31, 2007, (Attachment B). The motion was made by member Teixeira and seconded by member Cederquist to accept the financial statements as presented. Motion carried.		
Broker's Report Investment Policy	The broker, Bill Tucker Jr. mentioned one of the accreditation requirements was to annually review the O.S.S. Investment Policy. The O.S.S. adopts as its own policy the Fresno County Treasurer's Statement of Investment Policy. He stated for the record there have been no changes to the County's Investment Policy since the December 2005 revision.		
SELF vs SAFER	The broker briefly mentioned, at this time SELF has the lower rate for excess liability. There could be coverage differences between SELF and SAFER and would revisit this issue at an Executive Committee meeting later in the year.		

#### Broker's Report Cont. The Bill Tucker / Pat Magill Memorial Golf Tournament will be held this year on Thursday. June 21, 2007at the Sherwood Forest Golf Club in Sanger. All districts are encouraged to come Golf Tournament and join in on the fun day which includes a modified shotgun start, soft drinks and New York strip dinner afterwards. The claims administrator, Erik Knak was not in attendance. An O.S.S. claims update report was Administrator's Report presented by Mr. Tucker, (attachment C). Loss Control Report O.S.S. risk manager, Dr. Henry Brock reported on the new mandate which requires school districts to post Warning Signs at all playground areas. He mentioned new playgrounds already Playground Signs have the appropriate signs, only the older ones appear to be in need of these signs. Dr. Brock mentioned Pom & Associates had not invoiced the O.S.S. for their 05/06 safety Pom & Assoc inspections. He was looking into this discrepancy. The committee recessed at 11:35 a.m. and reconvened at 11:55 a.m. Action Items SETECH Report Dennis Williams from Keenan & Associates presented the O.S.S. Financial Management Information Report as of June 30, 2005 and June 30, 2006. It was reported that O.S.S. enjoys a secure financial position with an actuarially-determined greater than 90% confidence level funding of its outstanding liabilities, a stable rate structure and to date has paid out over \$6.3 million in dividends to its members. The motion was made by member Teixeira and seconded by member Nikkel to accept the report. (enclosed). Motion carried. The motion to accept the bylaw amendment clarifying the Withdrawal Reserve Account Bylaw Amendment WRA Clarification was made by member Cederquist and seconded by member Teixeira, (attachment D). Motion carried. Dr Brock presented an amendment to Policy #F-04, Facility Audits and Status Reports, Amendment of (attachment E). The amendment clarifies what the responsibilities of the district will be in their Policy F-04 reporting requirements. The motion to accept the F-04 Amendment as presented was made by member Materoh and seconded by member Teixeira. Motion carried. FASBO The broker requested that Fresno Area Self-Insurance Benefits Organization (F.A.S.B.O.) be accepted as a member in the O.S.S. as a sister JPA effective March 16, 2007. F.A.S.B.O. was Membership created to reduce the cost of health insurance services by participating in a risk sharing selfinsurance pool. Their membership consists of mostly O.S.S. member districts. The motion to accept F.A.S.B.O. as an O.S.S. member district effective March 16, 2007 was made by member Teixeira and seconded by member Nikkel. Roll call resulted in the following vote: AYES: Members Materoh, Romero, Jennings, Mungur, Foley, Nikkel, Teixeira, and Bates. NOES: None. ABSTENTIONS: Members Cederquist, and Williamson. ABSENT: Member Gustafson. Motion carried. The broker presented the loss fund rates with the modified premium for each member using a Loss Fund \$50,000 and \$100,000 SIR, (attachment F). The motion was made by member Cederquist and seconded by member Teixeira to recommend to the Board, approval of the loss fund rates. Motion carried.
