Loss Control for Schools

a) Safety Training

Title 8-3203, every employer shall establish, implement and maintain an effective Injury and Illness Prevention Program (IIPP). Employers must provide training and instruction when the IIPP is first established, to all new employees, to all employees given new job assignments for which training has not previously been received, whenever new substances, processes, procedures or equipment are introduced to the workplace and represent a new hazard, whenever the employer is made aware of a new or previously unrecognized hazard, and for supervisors to familiarize themselves with the safety and health hazards to which employees under their immediate direction and control may be exposed. Environmental Issues for Schools

- a) Indoor Air Quality
 - Perception of problem (odors, leaks, dirty filters or systems)
 - Education (how to operate HVAC controls, what not to bring into the classroom)
 - Communication (Teacher to Principal, Principal to Maintenance, and Maintenance back to Principal/Teacher.)
