She mentioned there were two districts late in paying their final audits, West Park Elementary and Raisin City Elementary. West Park had written a letter to the President stating they would be late and requested a late penalty waiver. Raisin City did not request a waiver. Both districts had recent personnel changes.

Broker's Report

The broker, Bill Tucker Jr. presented the Claims Cost Analysis for period ending September 2008, Claims Cost (Attachment D). Analysis

The broker mentioned the excess workers' compensation policy was emailed to the member Excess W/C districts in August. The excess coverage is written through Republic Indemnity Company of **Policies** America with a retention limit of \$500,000.

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Administrator's Report

Sharon Castillo, the F.C.S.I.G. claims administrator mentioned there seemed to be an increase of stress claims being reported and stated a number of claims had recently been investigated. She reported to the Board Tristar's decision to expand their Special Investigation Unit by partnering with Frasco Investigation Services, (Attachment E).

Loss Control Report

WeTip

F.C.S.I.G. risk manager, Dr. Henry Brock reported to the F.C.S.I.G. Board the property and casualty JPA is now participating in the WeTip School Safety Program. Should the Board be interested, WeTip also has a program which addresses workers' comp fraud in the workplace.

Slip & Falls

Dr. Brock pointed out that slip and falls seem to be more prevalent in the workplace than before. F.C.S.I.G. has an online safety module pertaining to this area that districts might want their employees to view for preventing future accidents.
