SUBJECT: School Security Officer Training

A school security officer is defined as "...any person primarily employed or assigned as a watchperson, security guard, or patrolperson on or about premises owned by a school district to protect persons or property or to prevent the theft of unlawful taking of district property of any kind or to report any unlawful activity to the district and local law enforcement agencies." SB 1626 requires 24 hours of training if the person is employed 20 hours or more weekly. If your district has employees that meet this description or you contract with a provider for those services please notify me so we can discuss training. Thank you.
