Meeting Minutes

Call to Order President Eric Cederquist called the meeting to order at 1:42 p.m.

Approval of	The motion to approve the agenda was made by member Teixeira and seconded by member

Public Hearing President Cederquist asked if anyone wished to address the Board. There was no response. **Session**

Consent Agenda The motion was made by member Porterfield and seconded by member Teixeira to approve the consent agenda which included the following:

- A. Approval of the minutes from the June 11, 2013 meeting as emailed.
- B. Approval of audited expenditures for quarter and year ending June 30, 2013, (Attachment A) and quarter ending September 30, 2013, (Attachment B). Motion carried.

Treasurer'sCarol Williamson, the F.C.S.I.G. accountant presented the audited financial statements for yearReportending June 30, 2013, (Attachment C) and for quarter ending September 30, 2013, (Attachment D).

- **Broker's Report** Claims Cost Analysis The broker, Bill Tucker, Jr. with Tucker-Alexander Insurance presented the claims cost analysis for period September 2013, (Attachment E). He reported the claim costs are increasing, though the claim numbers are lower as compared to the same period from the year prior.
- District Visits Mr. Tucker reported on the visits he and risk manager Henry Brock have made to districts with new superintendents / assistant superintendents. Their purpose is to acquaint them with the workings of F.C.S.I.G.

Administrator's The F.C.S.I.G. claims administrator, Sharon Castillo presented two detailed reports comparing the claims from year ending 6/30/11 to 6/30/12 and the year to date 9/30/12 to 9/30/13 (Attachment F). She mentioned there was a five percent (5%) increase in total paid for the 12/13 year, while the year to date showed for its first quarter an increase of nine percent (9%) from the year prior. She verified what the broker said earlier, the claims count has been decreasing, but the costs are increasing.

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Loss Control Report

- F.C.S.I.G. risk manager, Dr. Henry Brock due to a scheduling conflict, was unable to attend. Three Claims Experience reports which he provides to the districts each year showing how their loss experience affects their bottom line was presented by the broker, Bill Tucker. The reports are 3 Year Claims/ADA Ratio; Dollar Loss Incurred/ADA Ratio; 3 Year Dollar Loss/Savings by District; (Attachment G).
- Injury Report Forms The broker briefly reported on the three worker's compensation forms the risk manager emailed to the JPA Liaisons and Contact People/Safety Officers pertaining to reporting of an injury or illness and steps taken to prevent similar losses.
- Action Items Gustavo Corona with the firm, Borchardt, Corona & Faeth presented the F.C.S.I.G. financial audit for years ending June 30, 2013 and 2012, (Attachment H). He mentioned F.C.S.I.G. maintains its **Financial Audit** financial statements on a cash basis. Workers' compensation rates are starting to increase with medical being a huge factor. He declared all items to be fairly stated, noting internal controls working properly. The motion to accept the F.C.S.I.S. financial audit for years ending June 30, 2013 and 2012 was made by member Teixeira and seconded by member Porterfield. Motion carried.
 - SETECH Rpt. The SETECH Report, A Financial management Information Report For the Fiscal Years Ended June 30, 2013, (Attachment I), was presented by Justin Lockhart from the SETECH Division of Keenan & Associates. He mentioned F.C.S.I.G. has been conservative in reserving and returning equity in the older program years to its members while continuing to enjoy secure finances and a stable rate structure. The motion to accept the report as presented was made by member Porterfield and seconded by member Teixeira. Motion carried.
 - Claims Audit The broker presented the proposals received from the Request For Proposal (RFP) he sent out for a claims audit, (Attachment J). He recommended the claims audit proposal submitted by Timothy Farley with Farley Consulting Services, LLC. It was moved by member Teixeira and seconded by member Williamson to award the claims audit to Farley Consulting Services, LLC. Motion carried.
 - The Public Self Insurer's Annual Report was presented by the broker, (Attachment K). This report is Ann'l Rpt filed annually with the State of California, Department of Industrial Relations Self Insurance Plans and is used to determine the User Funding and Fraud Assessments to name just a few of the assessments made by the state. Member Teixeira made the motion which was seconded by member Porterfield to accept the report as presented. Motion carried.

Board Member President Cederquist asked if any member had items to report. There was no response.
