SessionPresident Cederquist asked if anyone wished to address the Board. There was no
response.

Broker's Report Remarketing of Insurance The JPA manager, Bill Tucker spoke in length about the remarketing process. From a field of eight Joint Powers Authorities (JPAs), three responded to the request for proposals. Two had pricing which was much higher than that of the Alliance of Schools for Cooperative Insurance Programs (ASCIP) and of the current F.C.S.I.G. program. While the ASCIP premium was lower than the F.C.S.I.G. renewal premium, ASCIP would only offer their Worker's Comp program if the Organization of Self Insured Schools, (O.S.S.) went with the ASCIP property and liability program which was much higher than the Northern California ReLiEF (NCR) property & liability proposal, (Attachment A). The JPA Manager's recommendation for F.C.S.I.G. is renew under its current structure with serious consideration being given to reducing the confidence level to 50% for 1 - 2 years.
