Treasurer's Report

The O.S.S. accountant, Carol Bray presented the financial statement for period ending May 15, 2016, (Attachment A).

Broker's Report

Districts Leaving OSS

The JPA manager, Bill Tucker Jr. reported on the districts departing from the O.S.S. effective 7/1/16: Kings Canyon Unified School District, Sanger Unified School District, and Golden Plains Unified School District.

Golf Tournament

Administrator's Report

The claims administrator for the O.S.S., Erik Knak from Knak & Company, presented the O.S.S. Loss History Review – (Incurred) – 5-17-2016 for years 2006-07 through 2015-16, (Attachment B). He mentioned the total reserves as compared to the year prior is flat with fewer open claims. The three districts leaving had approximately \$175,000 a year in losses within the \$50,000 SIR, so we should be seeing a gradual decline in total incurred claims.

Loss Control Report

Dr. Brock, O.S.S. risk manager reported on the areas of risk management he is currently involved, (Attachment C). Highlights include:

Loss reports geared to each district are soon to be distributed and reviewed with their liaison, safety committee and/or safety officer. Charter school issues surrounding both dependent and independent charter schools will be addressed in an upcoming workshop. Plans are to have an active shooter/lockdown DVD distributed to the districts before their fall staff in-services. A security analysis is planned to be incorporated into the next tri-annual safety audit.

Action Items

Loss Fund Rates

The JPA manager presented the loss fund rate at the \$50,000 S.I.R. level with the modified premium for each member comparing the 2016/17 year with that from 2015/16, (Attachment D). There was a question on the ADA used. The manager reported the ADA came from the State and was the 14/15 Lottery ADA which would be based on enrollment. The motion to approve the loss fund renewal rate was made by member Cederquist and seconded by member Machado.

NCR Rates

The JPA manager presented the NCR liability and property rates to the Board as recommended by the Executive Committee for approval, (Attachment E). There was an extremely small change / increase in the rates coming from NorCal ReLiEF (NCR) for 2016/17. Almost all the increase cost will be from increases to the NCR experience factors from the prior years and are a direct reflection of the claims experience of the O.S.S. members. The motion to approve the NCR rates and extended premiums as presented was made by member Machado and seconded by member Singh.

Charter School Plcy

The JPA manager presented the independent charter school policy as approved by the Executive Committee to the Board for their consideration. Member Parkin suggested changes to the wording and was concerned with the required \$50,000,000 limit of liability. There was also a concern if the policy would require those charters in the middle of their agreements to be required to purchase

Charter School Plcy the higher liability limits. Discussion on grandfathering in current charters, making the requirement apply to new and renewing independent charter agreements with the assurance by the JPA manager that higher liability limits were available for independent charters. After a lengthy discussion, the motion was made by member Cederquist and seconded by member Magnussen to approve the Independent Charter School Indemnity Policy, effective 07/01/16 with the suggested changes.
