Employers are required to protect their employees by implementing an IIPP that addresses the following:



Establish Responsibility

- Management, Supervisors, Lead Foreman, Employees



Ensure Compliance

- Code of Safe Work Practices



Communicate Safety

- Safety Committees, Memos, Postings



Hazard Identification

- Periodic Safety Inspections, Site Evaluations



Investigate

- Hazards, Injuries, Illnesses, Near Misses



Correct

- Unsafe Conditions, Practices, and Procedures



Train and Instruct

- Job Specific Hazards, New Procedures



Document and Retain

- Reports, Training Records, Hazard Analysis
