Erik Knak, Claims Administrator for the OSS presented his Loss History Review – (Incurred) – 10/03/18, for review. The years 2009/10, 2010/11, 2011/12, 2013/14, and 2014/15 have no open claims with 2012/13 having 1 newly opened claim involving a sexual molestation case. 2015/16 has 2 open claims, 2016/17 has 7 open claims, 2017/18 has 18 open claims and the current 2018/19 year has 16 open claims ending the period with a total of 35 open claims, with current reserves of \$548,000. Tyler Houston reported on the recent veto by Governor Brown of **AB3120** which would have greatly expanded the deadline in which to file a sexual molestation claim. He also reported on the Executive Summaries from the NCR Underwriting, Risk Management, Finance, Executive, & the Claims & Coverage Committees. Highlights mentioned were:

- Booster clubs currently covered under their districts' MOC will need to get their own coverage as of 7/1/19.
- Child abuse series in Keenan Safe Schools has been expanded to include a series of micro-learning videos.
- Funds have been set aside to assist Districts with Title IX Compliance.

IX. FINANCIAL

TREASURER'S REPORT

The Executive Committee reviewed the audited Treasurer's Report for Year ending June 30, 2018 and the Treasurer's Report for Quarter ending September 30, 2018 for approval.

FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT INFORMATION REPORT

Mary Boyer with SETECH a division of Keenan & Associates presented the Financial Management Information Report for the Fiscal Years Ended June 30, 2017 and June 30, 2018 to the Executive Committee. The net position has increased from 06/30/2017 by \$583,232. The following represents the most significant changes:

- The deposit of the 2017/2018 member contributions for future claims of \$983,090.
- Net investment income earned of \$88,376.
- A decrease in the actuarially determined estimated ultimate losses of \$295,498 for the program years 2016/2017 and prior due to decreased in claims activity.

The increase to the Net Position was offset by:

- The recognition of the actuarially determined estimated ultimate incurred of \$770,000 for the 2017/2018 program year.
- An increase in members withdrawal liability of \$52,425.

Overall, OSS has continued to enjoy secure financial success, a stable rate structure, and as a result they have declared, to date, dividends of \$8,920,096.

FINANCIAL AUDIT REPORT

Gustavo Corona, the auditor for the OSS, presented the Financial Audit Report for Years ending June 30, 2018 and 2017 to the Executive Committee for their review and approval. The auditor stated it was an unqualified opinion with no findings of internal control issues.

An amendment to the 18/19 Financial Budget was presented to the Executive Committee. The unused budgeted amount from the 2017/2018 Loss Control training material of \$22,800 was proposed to be added to the current year's budget, increasing that line item from \$25,000 to \$47,800.

- Per AB 2009 as of 7/1/2019, if a school district or charter school elects to offer any interscholastic athletic programs, the bill would ensure a written emergency action plan to be in place and posted that describes the location and procedures to be followed in the event of sudden cardiac arrest or other medical emergencies related to the athletic program's activities or events. It also requires at least one automated external defibrillator (AED) for each school within the school district or the charter school to be available on campus, are available for the purpose of rendering emergency care or treatment within a recommended three to five minutes of sudden cardiac arrest and are available to athletic trainers and coaches and authorized persons at these activities or events.
